Renaming expanded numeric or string tables used in ioControl and OptoControl watch windows

SYMPTOMS

Renaming an expanded numeric or string table used in a watch window, causes an error when switching into debug mode. The error prevents going into debug mode, and an error message similar to the following is displayed:

WORKAROUND

Rename the numeric or string table variable back to the original name, or delete the original watch window and create a new watch window with the renamed table name.
